Job Overview

Reporting to the Production Manager, as the **Labourer - Truss** you will provide support to the Truss manufacturing team. You also organize and inspect the complete trusses to ensure compliance with quality standard and consistent with order quantity.

Your day-to-day responsibilities will include:

- Maintaining sufficient raw material at the station in an organized manner.
- Verifying truss type, quality and quantity for consistency with orders prior to stacking trusses in bundles. Banding complete bundles together according to job number and stack size.
- Monitoring trusses for sheeting requirements and applying sheeting using an air stapler and router as necessary.
- Indicating order number on the side of the package and keeping system updated at various stages of the Truss manufacturing process.
- Reviewing quality of trusses and plate placement to ensure proper installation, and notifying the lead hand of any quality issues.
- Assisting and/or coaching other team members on the line when necessary.

Work Conditions

You primarily work outside during regular business hours. Work has exposure to noise from equipment/machinery and occupational hazards as well as dealing with inclement weather. Physically able to kneel and crouch as well as lift, carry, push or pull objects weighing up to 50 lbs. Overtime may occasionally be required.
