Reporting to the Manufacturing Manager, as the **Manufacturing Maintenance Technician** you will maintain production and quality by ensuring mechanical and electrical operation of manufacturing machinery.

Your day-to-day responsibilities will include:

- Ensuring operation and unplanned downtime of machinery and mechanical equipment by completing preventive and corrective maintenance requirements liaising with Manufacturing and/or Production Manager.
- Fixing equipment, such as motors, gearboxes, pneumatic systems, coupling and motor alignment, roller chain and sprocket alignment, conveyor systems, computer systems, and production machines.
- Removing, repairing, and replacing defective parts by dismantling devices using tools as required. Locating sources of problems by observing mechanical and/or electrical devices in operation.
- Following diagrams, sketches, operations manuals, manufacturer's instructions, and engineering specifications.
- Interfacing with vendors, OEM and ODM suppliers.
- Troubleshooting malfunctions and complying with CEC standards on wiring and installations.
- Communicating irregularities with Production Manager and scheduling correction of abnormalities, documenting actions.
- Educating equipment operators on appropriate set-up, preventive maintenance and general operation procedures – best practices.
- Maintaining a safe and clean working environment by complying with procedures, rules, and regulations.
