DUTIES:

- Supervises all warehouse and yard staff and directs them accordingly
- Works in the yard/warehouse building customer orders
- Unloads incoming shipments of building materials and places into designated warehouse/yard positions.
- Responsible for daily operating efficiency (including wage expenses, inventory damages and order "fill" accuracy)
- Responsible for checking incoming vendor shipments for accuracy and condition
- Responsible for the upkeep, maintenance, housekeeping and repairs of warehouse and yard facilities including equipment, structures, signage, racking systems, lighting, controls,
- Responsible for security of both warehouse and yard facilities
- Responsible for inventory handling and management
- Conducts interviews for warehouse/yard candidates and provides training and development
- Conducts regular staff meetings
- Continuous and regular communication with the Dispatcher and Branch/OpsManager
- Must check, sign-off, and authorize release of all built-up orders prior to their loading
- Prepares and distributes the "Saturday Task" list.
- Regularly conducts a thorough walk-about of yard and warehouse with the Branch Administrator and Operations Manager.
- Additional duties may be assigned by the Branch/Operations Manager.
