You use architectural drawings and building codes to optimize the design of wall panels for production.

- Working on and understanding complete complex structures and the process of architectural, structural, and mechanical consultants. Working with third parties or consultants
- Maintaining high level of organization, documenting projects, managing project costing, and generating RFI's.
- Complete projects within multiple technical disciplines of wall panels for complex structures.
- Managing design work schedule to ensure jobs are completed on time.
- Creating computer models using computer-aided design (CAD) software.
- Reviewing and interpreting customer-supplied documents, such as blueprints or drawings, to identify if any areas require clarification.
- Completing fabrication ready designs for residential home structures.
- Implementing design changes and communicating with other related departments to ensure designs are accurate and consistent.
- Reviewing constructability of the projects and identifying opportunities for value engineering.
- Preparing fabrication packages for production department, and site packages for installers.
